- 2." The Education of a Photographer" Edited by Charles H. Traub, Steven Heller & Adam B. Bell A collection of writings by a diverse group of people all focusing on photography in some way, including pieces by Berenice Abbott, Minor White, Irving Penn and many others.
- 3. "Inside the Photograph" Peter C. Bunnell Another collection of essays on 20th century photography, including Edward Weston's monograph "On Photography" a fascinating book.
- 4. "The Photograph as Contemporary Art" Charlotte Cotton From "snapshots" to carefully constructed settings, this book considers all the ways today's artists engage in photography to make art.
